<u>Objective</u>: To put together a puzzle - in a slightly different way. Each group will need a <u>director</u>, a blindfolded **assembler**, and **enforce** (who will enforce the rules in another group).

<u>Directions</u>: Have one member of your group come to the front and obtain a blindfold. Blindfold one member of the group. After blindfolding, obtain a puzzle from your teacher. Also, at this time, have the group's "Enforcer" come to the teacher for assignment to another group. The blindfolded member must assemble the puzzle correctly with director only able to give <u>VERBAL DIRECTIONS</u>. The director is NOT allowed to position pieces, touch the blindfolded member, or do anything other than give verbal directions.

NOTE: The blindfolded member

and director must sit opposite each

other. The enforcer should sit to the side of them, and make sure the other two stay "legal". See

Diagram.

Winner: The winner will be the group, which <u>correctly assembles</u>: their puzzle, without cheating, in the shortest amount of time. The group that finishes first will have each member receive 3 bonus points, the group which finishes second will have each member receive 2 bonus points, and the group that finishes third will have each member receive 1 bonus point.

Analyze your success (or failure), and some of the problems that you had when trying to assemble the		
puzzle. Did you observe ways that other groups may have tried to "cheat"? (YOU, of course, DID NOT		
cheat!) This analysis should contain information from all three members of your group, and is worth a		
grade! (15 points)
